



## PROJECT COMPONENT DETAILS

### **Pritzker Military Archives Center (PMAC)**

The Pritzker Military Archives Center is located on the highest point of the property, on the Northeast corner. This space will support the Pritzker Military Museum & Library's (PMML) mission to preserve the past, present, and future of the citizen soldier. The building is a state-of-the-art center to further the mission of the Pritzker Military Museum & Library, through restoration, preservation, and storage of its collection. The facility is necessary due to the overwhelming support of donors and families eager to protect their family's legacy and stories. Along with the archival space, workspace for the Pritzker Military Museum & Library staff will be included for continued curation of the military collection for future exhibits. It will also feature a 9,500 square foot Gallery Center for public viewing.

### **Mission94 Firearms Education Center**

Safety, awareness, education, and training are leading principles at Mission 94. Education and training in a safe, non-intimidating environment by top-rated certified instructors will be a hallmark of the facility. The facility will allow researchers and others the opportunity to test historical replicas and modern firearms to better understand the experiences of the citizen soldier.

### **Cold War Veterans Memorial (CWVM)**

Dedicated to those who have served from 1945-1991.  
Will be a publicly accessible display where citizens can honor, reflect and learn about the bravery and sacrifice displayed to further the freedom that our country enjoys.

### **Commercial Archives**

The Commercial Archives is envisioned as a high-tech, highly-secured, state-of-the-art facility that will adhere to best practices in conservation, housing archives and collections of all types.

### **Community Green Space**

Dedicated public access to walking and bike paths and picnicking areas.  
The green space will surround the Pritzker Military Archives Center and Cold War Veterans Memorial and includes 7,440 linear feet of walking paths.  
All will be publicly accessible during business hours.

## ENVIRONMENTALLY CONSCIENTIOUS

Wetlands will remain undisturbed.

Buildings will be energy efficient and utilize solar panels and rainwater collection/re-use. Site will preserve as much green space as possible; less than 7% of the entire site for the buildings.
